WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

In this course you will learn to use theatre skills to add impact and authenticity to your communication as a group leader. The first step is to realise that the people you lead respond to the signals you send out, and that your overall performance generates feelings that can be either helpful or not.

You will learn to apply theatre skills to make the feeling you generate in the people you lead more helpful. By becoming aware of the kind of feeling you generate automatically, you will be able to aim for more effective interaction. You will learn to optimise your performance as a group leader in various communication settings, ranging from addressing the group as a whole to one-on-one conversations and bringing difficult messages.

You will experiment in a role-play setting whereby you will not only act as a group leader, but also take the role of group member when other participant are practising. This gives you ample opportunity to experience the effects of behavioural changes. You will be recorded on video to enable you to review your own performance as a group leader.

All in all you will learn to:

- become more able to adjust your behaviour to a certain situation
- 2. induce feelings in your group that are helpful to them
- 3. avoid ineffective signals in your role as group leader
- 4. develop various styles of communicating for various settings
- 5. communicate your messages more convincingly
- 6. remain convincing when you change the subject

PRACTICALITIES

Leaderships Theatre consists of three half days with meetings every two weeks. Homework in between sessions adds up to three hours in total. You will be provided with a booklet detailing the course content. When you complete at least 80% of the course you will receive a certificate at the end. The number of participants per trainer is ideally 4 to 6.

You can take this course as an individual in our open course offer. If enough of your colleagues are interested, the course can also be taken together at your place of work. As set-up, we would need a classroom with the tables cleared to the walls and a flipchart.
